

WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN AN ANIMAL COMMUNICATOR

- **⑤** Training and Credentials Not all animal communicators are created equal. While some people practice strictly intuitively, with no formal training in the field. I believe there is no substitute for professional training, certifications, and experience. My own training is a twofold technique, which includes working with your animal in what I call the 3D format, which is the day-to-day personality you know best, as well as the equally important Soul Level® format, in which their higher self brings you the big picture reason regarding what they want you to learn as you evolve during your time together.
- © Code of Ethics The Animal Communicator should be able to accurately understand what your animal is feeling and thinking, and what the issues are from their viewpoint. The animals convey through the Communicator information that may affirm what you already know (which is valuable in itself) or reveal new information you didn't know before. The Communicator will seek to provide clarity regarding possible solutions from the animal's perspective and will answer your questions to the best of the animals' ability. All sessions are kept in confidence.
- The Process Animal Communicators are trained to listen telepathically to animals. The animals are every bit as much a client as the human family members. We do our best to provide you with evidence that we are indeed in contact with your animal. We then relay what we receive from them using all the senses available to us, however we too can make mistakes even though we are doing the best we can. We do not predict the future (animals focus very much in the present), and we are not intending to read your mind but rather to understand theirs.
- **⊗** Skeptics vs Cynics While it is understandable to be a little skeptical at first, it is counter-productive to go into a session with a cynical mindset. A cynic's mind is closed to all other perspectives than their own point of view, and even the best Animal Communicator will not be able to provide enough evidence to a closed mind. If you can listen with an open mind and heart, but not be so open minded that you lose your common sense, there is overwhelmingly positive potential for a successful outcome. Please be aware that not everything we receive telepathically is going to be 100% accurate. TV edits sessions and only shows viewers the hits and highlights, however in real life even the best psychics in the world are only about 80% accurate. Some do better than 80% at times, and sometimes we are off. You may find, however, that your animal's behavior and mood will change positively just through making a heartfelt effort to communicate with them.

- **Solution** Your Role If something feels off or you are hearing things that do not make sense, a good Animal Communicator will want you to speak up. We would much rather hear your honest feedback, so we can have an opportunity to ask the animal to explain things to us in a different way. The animals must work with us through our own individual frame of reference, so trying again is part of the process.
- Remember, we are Practitioners! That means we are practicing, just as other professional practitioners including veterinarians, counselors, and other service providers. We do our best to assist, given our experience, skills and training.
- Selatability There may be a few Animal Communicators who appeal to you based on mutual areas of special interest and expertise. Some work primarily with pets while others prefer to work mostly with farm animals and horses. Some are excellent at finding lost pets, while others specialize as animal behaviorists, end of life doulas, etc. Does the explanation of their pre-meeting process and what kind of preparation is needed for a session with them appeal to you? You may also want to email them a question to see if they have worked with a certain kind of issue before. Listen with your heart as they engage with you. If you feel good with this person, then make an appointment.
- **S** Guarantee What will they do if things go wrong, or you are unhappy with your session? Knowing the Animal Communicator's policy upfront will give you peace of mind and help assure that you will be working with someone reputable and professional.
- Realistic Expectations No one can make your animals change if they don't want to. Sometimes a behavioral problem isn't with the animal. There are times when the root of the issue lies with the animal's people, the situation the animal is in, who is handling their management, changes in their diet, their history and background, their breeding, and especially their prior training or lack thereof. Most animals have a sincere desire to be a part of the pack/team/family, and they always do what makes sense to them from their viewpoint. Our job is to discover what their viewpoint is and then to work with you to help resolve the problem.

Your animals have chosen to spend their lives trying to help you break cycles and move past your own back story, scars and limiting beliefs. They do this so that as you heal you can evolve and see your life from a fresh and more meaningful perspective. I like to think of it as a Divinely Inspired Joint Venture Agreement!
